## To All Villagers from the Board of Trustees - an Important Request

As you are likely aware, the Village is now in a position to proceed with its program of sterilization and culling in order to reduce the number of deer that are causing motor vehicle and bicycle accidents, inflicting damage to property and endangering public health in Cayuga Heights. Your patience and strong support have brought the deer program through its prolonged adoption. Now it is up to our community to make it happen.

The first phase of the plan is hire White Buffalo, Inc., a non-profit wildlife management and research organization, to begin sterilizing a core population of does this winter along with an initial culling of up to 85 deer.

For the program to succeed, a sufficient number of property owners in different parts of the Village must agree to have sterilization and/or culling take place on their land. Once a property owner gives permission for a sterilization and/or culling site, the Village will need to obtain the permission of every property owner within a 500 feet radius of that site in order to proceed.

Enclosed please find the landowner consent form that explains the terms of participation and lists options that give permission for baiting deer on your property, their capture and removal for sterilization, and/or the discharge of a weapon to kill them and remove the carcasses. The deer culled will be processed and the venison given to the Food Bank of the Southern Tier for free food distribution. Indemnification of property owners by the Village is included in the program.
